5th Annual Report - Academic Year 2021-22

ACADEMICS

Academics takes prominent place in education field. The Covid-19 pandemic forced educators to transform the teaching method in a different mode. Online as well as Offline classes were to be taken for the students to continue their learning. Though school reopened from August, it was an uphill task for the teaching community to bring every child to come in line with the learning outcomes.

For the 2020-21 batch 10th students, no examination was held by the CBSE Board. The result was calculated based on previous years average marks.

As per the guidelines from the board, an evaluation committee was established and finalised the marks allotment. Accordingly, the result was announced by the CBSE board.

The second batch of 10th class students numbering **352/352** from our institution passed out from our school... The batch topper is **B.SAI SAMSKRUTHI. By scoring 487/500 Marks/Grade**. <u>190</u> students got 10 GPAs from our school. The complete information is presented hereunder in a tabular model.

From the core of my heart, I congratulate all the students for the laurels they brought to our institution. At the same time, I thank all the teaching and nonteaching staff for the co-operation they extended to get this tremendous result.

Due to Covid pandemic, the school reopened on August 16 2021. This A.Y 2021-22, there were <u>393</u> students appeared for Board exams. This year CBSE Board conducted the examination in 2 terms. The First Term in the months of November-December, 2021 and the Second Term in the months of April-May 2022. The First Term results were announced without any grades, in which our students scored excellent marks. This year, I expect better results than the previous year.

Highlights of 2021-22

- This A.Y as Covid -19 pandemic has eased, we celebrated a good number of programmes.
- Apart from National Festivals-Independence Day, Republic Day, Our school celebrated Festival of Ratha Saptami, where in 7th to 9th class students participated in the demonstration of Yoga postures.
- Mathematics Day was observed conducting various Mathematics related activities.
- Science Fair was organized on February 25th & 26th on the Occasion of C.V.Raman's Science Day. (Feb-28th)
- Indus Literati Fest 2021 was organized block-wise to showcase the talent of student's skill in English through singing, mono action and Dramas.
- One Day games were held to all the classes in the month of March-April and the winners were awarded with mementos.
- Children were given chance to participate in SOF's IGKO, IEO, National Science Olympiad and International Mathematics Olympiad. The results of the same are yet to be received.
